The pursuit of projects and more......

La Maison l'Arc-en-Ciel (MAEC) has already set up organic market gardening, the production of broilers, laying hens, beekeeping, vermicompost and is trying to add rabbit farming to its activities (rabbit breeding). She therefore joined forces with her agronomist consultant, Jhonny, whom we spoke about in a newsletter published in June 2020, to carry out an experiment on **rabbit feeding** as part of his final thesis for obtaining his agricultural engineering diploma. This collaboration will allow our institution to benefit from the training, expertise and donation of about thirty rabbits.



Other experiments have been initiated by MAEC and are currently being tested: a small pilot project to breed insects, the banana weevil, which is harmful to this crop, and which could be beneficial as a protein diet for chickens in breeding.



Palma Christi oil production

Palma Christi oil is extracted from the castor bean with **anti-inflammatory and antibacterial** properties, for **sprains**, engorgement and **stains** in **poultices**. It is rich in vitamin E. It is also used for the treatment of hair and skin in general. For the first time, MAEC was able to collect enough seeds to proceed with the long and tedious preparation of this oil, which requires experience, attention and patience according to a tradition passed down through generations, the oil will be used to rub children infected by the flu, or having pulmonary weakness and even in the event of Covid 19.

Its tender young shoots, with a mild flavor, give and interesting texture to salads and soups. In addition, it is rich in vitamins A, B1, B2, C, E and PP, phosphorus, calcium and iron.
