With the financial support of our Foundation, La Maison l'Arc-en-Ciel begun various maintenance and development projects in order to protect the building and improve the living conditions of the children.

Moreover, in a context of great shortage of electricity, not to mention the recent increase in the price of fuel (from 169 gourdes to 354 gdes/gallon) to power the generator, La Maison l'Arc-en-Ciel is aiming for partial autonomy by installing solar panels. The first phase of the project consists of replacing the tin roof on the building adjacent to the home with a concrete slab. Various partners are involved in this project.

Last October, the Foundation sent, thanks to your donations, three barrels to La Maison l'Arc-en-Ciel in Haiti. This shipment contained used clothes and shoes in good condition (donated by donors), some Christmas gifts, a wheelchair and plastic bins to store the children's clothes.

May we remind you that the barrels have a second life: they are used for water storage for the gardens, for composting and for food storage.

NEW EXPANSION PROJECT... The fig-banana!

In the fall a *kombit* was held with the children. This activity allowed to realize, in a well needed environment of game and pleasure, the plantation of 200 banana plants, as much the fruit as the vegetable, the enrichment of the soil by the contribution of natural manure, the cleaning of all the fruit trees and their amendment. Days rich in sharing and awareness.

The most profitable crop now is the banana (fruit) which now represents 50% of our sales while benefiting more and more the children by the multiplication of transformable products. The whole plant is used from the flower that the children consume to the plant itself consumed by the farm animals.

(Kombit a traditional form of work organization built around a philosophy based on the foundations of mutual aid and living together.)

Investing in time... A brief review of our activities

Since 1997, a valiant team has generously devoted itself to the humanitarian work of the couple formed by Mrs. Danielle Reid, a Quebecer, and Mr. Robert Pénette, a Haitian.

Thanks to generous benefactors and many partners, La Maison l'Arcen-Ciel d'Haiti has continued to progress from one year to the next for the benefit of our little protégés: acquisition of a large piece of land located in the mountains in order to avoid the immense pollution of Port-au-Prince for the children and employees, the construction of three hen houses, beehives, hutches, freezers, refrigerators, stainless steel tables for cutting up chickens, an indispensable generator, agricultural equipment, industrial washers and dryers, etc. In addition, a large vegetable garden with a wide variety of fruits and vegetables (banana trees, plantains, etc.) has been developed.

In order to ensure greater security, it was necessary to erect a tenfoot-high wall around the immense property.

All this development would not have been possible without your repeated support. The difficulties were immense, but together we made the difference.
